Increase in Meal Cost.

We will continue to serve all pupils with a freshly prepared lunch, using 95% fresh ingredients, along with a choice of dessert, fresh cut fruit and yoghurt. Pupils can also help themselves to the salad bar.

We would like to remind all parents who have children in Reception, years 1 and 2 are entitled to a government paid Free school lunch.

I can also confirm that there will be no further increases in the 2024-2025 academic year and the tariffs displayed will remain in place all year.




